The accreditation cards will be handed out at the event office at Scandic Lillehammer Hotel. Please note that the accreditations will be approved according to the registrations in the FIS Entry. Those who have the FIS season accreditation can use this instead of the local accreditation.

Prices and rules:

- Booking according to the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system: https://www.fis-ski.com/DB/?authentication_page=signin
- The OC will cover accommodation costs according to the FIS World Cup rules
- The price for accommodation outside of the quota or for additional nights is CHF 125 per person in a double room or apartment (minimum number of persons occurs). The price for additional single rooms is CHF 160.
- In case of extra single rooms inside the quota the cost difference between single and double room must be paid
- For NCM: For nations with starting quota 4 or more the OC will cover two single rooms

FIS Entry deadlines

Preliminary entries: 25/10/2024 Entries: 28/11/2024

Cancellation rules and fees:

Please see World Cup Rules article 6.2.1 for W and 6.1.2 for M

- Cancellation fee between 8 days and until the end of the events: 100% cancellation fee
- For cancellations of more than what is stated in the rules above the OC will charge a 100% cancellation fee

Official transport and shuttle

Official transport:

- Official airport: Oslo Airport Gardermoen
- For OC transportation, please fill in your request through the FIS online registration system: https://www.fis-ski.com/DB/?authentication_page=signin
- There will be a limited number of OC departures from/to the airport.

Alternative transportation (if no OC bus):

• Train: Direct train (approx one departure every hour, except for in the night). Please see the schedule/order here: https://www.vy.no/en. Choose Oslo Lufthavn (the airport) to Lillehammer. Alternatively buy the ticket at the airport/station or on board the train.









Shuttle to the venues:

• There will be shuttle service between the hotel and the venues. For shuttle times see the transportation desk at your hotel reception or at the event office at Scandic Lillehammer Hotel.

Carrying costs/Reimbursement:

Travel money and payment

- Travel money will be deducted from accommodation above quota and paid by bank transfer. Please send us updated bank information to silje.solbakken@olympiaparken.no
- Accommodation costs above quota: Teams will pay directly in the event office at Scandic Lillehammer Hotel. Only credit cards will be accepted.
- In case you are not able to pay by card, please send us your invoice information in advance.
- For teams that already know that all their accommodation is inside the quota, please send us updated bank information.

Prize money payment

Prize Money will be paid by bank transfer to the athletes after the event. The prize money is regulated by the FIS World Cup Rules. Receipts will be provided to the athlete electronically and a copy transmitted to FIS.

Income tax information for prize money

- Income tax of European citizens is 15%
- Income tax of non-European citizens is 15% (USA 0%)

 Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Norwegian Foreign Artist Taxation Act, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

Waxing facilities

- Wax cabins are available from 02/12/2024 at 12:00.
- The keys to the cabins are available at the wax building office (CC venue) and at the lift station (SJ venue).
- Keys return to the wax building office (CC) / lift station (SJ) on the day of departure.
- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks have to inform the OC before the preliminary deadline
- Wax cabins for SRS companies according to World Cup rules. The companies must communicate to the OC their requests (parking size, power supply, etc.).

Team Catering

Costs for lunch service at venue is CHF 10 per person for those out of quota or for those who haven't ordered and paid full board via the Organising Committee. Opening hours to be announced at TCM.

Regulations of radio equipment/radio frequencies

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Norway is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications.

To participate in FIS events all athletes must possess a valid FIS Code.

All athletes need the insurance arranged by their NSA. LOC is not responsible for any injuries of the athletes neither for the damage or lost property.

Regulations of Visa

Remember that citizens of some countries will need a visa for visiting Norway. Please check with your embassy if you need a visa for Norway.

Truck driving and routes

Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday- and night, other days with special regulations)

• There is no need for a special permission for truck driving on Norwegian roads. No special rules and regulations, except for the normal Norwegian weather and snow conditions and the need of snow tires.








Arena Maps
